Interpreting Your ILTS Score Report

Your ILTS score report provides your results and a description of your performance for the test taken on the test date.

1 Reporting

Your scores are automatically reported to the ISBE. The Illinois educator preparation program(s) listed receive your scores as you indicated during registration.

2 Scaled Total Test Score

Your scaled total test score is reported on a scale from 100 to 300. Your scaled total test score is based on your performance on the entire test: the number of multiple-choice questions answered correctly combined with any constructed-response assignment score(s).

3 Status

If you received a scaled total test score of 240 or above, you will receive a "Pass" status. If you received a scaled total test score below 240, you will receive a "Did not pass" status. To pass the entire test, you must pass each subtest.
